ALL ATVs MUST HAVE

1. Licence Plate
2. Insurance
3. Working Headlights
4. Working Tail Lights

ATV DRIVERS MUST

1. Have a valid driver's license
2. Wear a proper helmet

DO NOT

1. Ride at night
2. Trespass on private property
3. Ride in the City of Chatham
4. Ride on non-designated roads

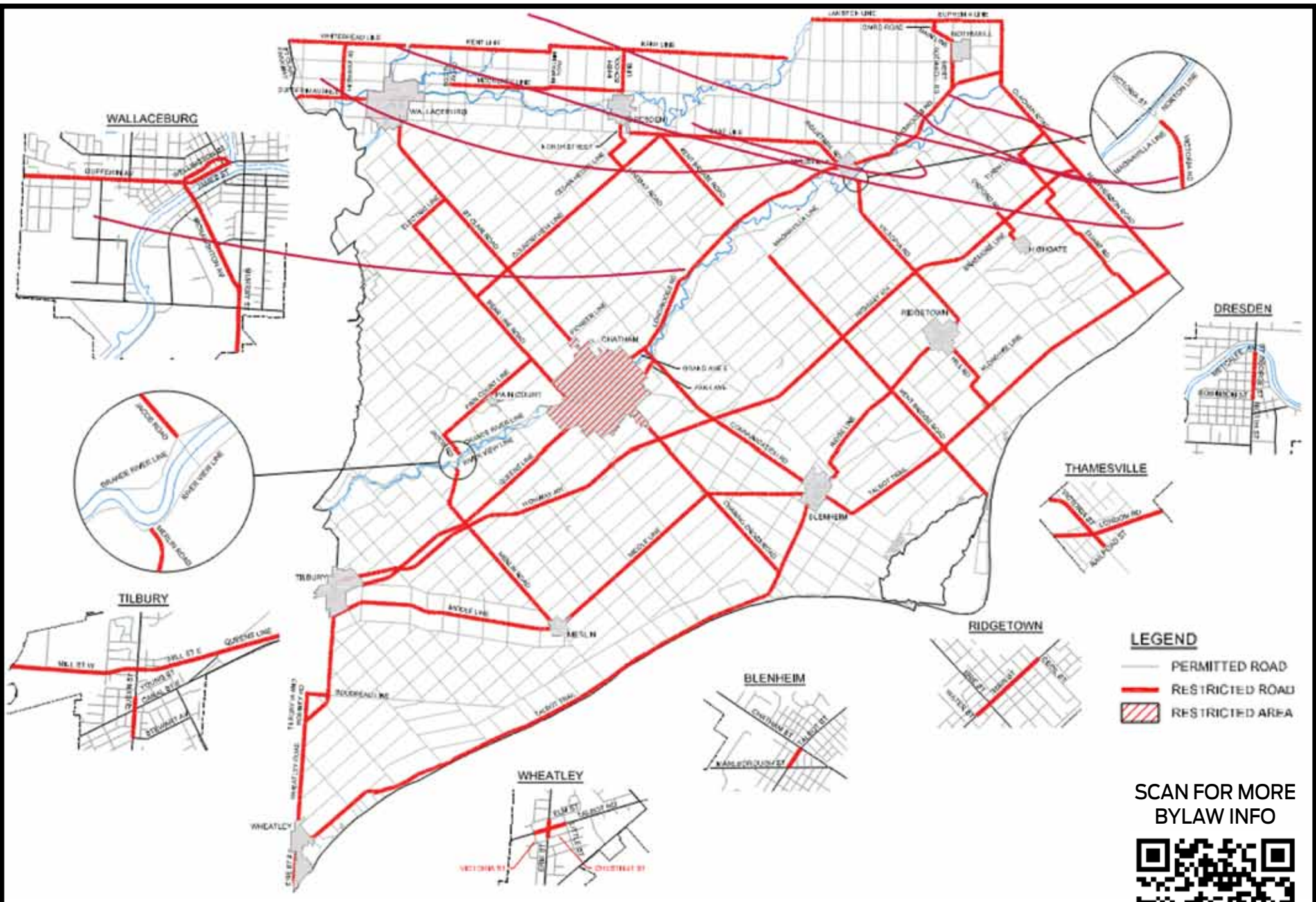
